RESOLUTION

Approval of Contract for Website Redevelopment

WHEREAS, the Forest Preserves of Winnebago County's two websites (FPWC and FPWC Golf) are outdated in structure, software, and accessibility standards; and

WHEREAS, all web and mobile content owned and created by the Forest Preserves of Winnebago County must comply with WCAG 2.1, Level AA standards by April 26, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the FPWC and FPWC Golf websites average between 15,461 and 16,265 views per month, of which between 69% and 74% these views are via a mobile device, highlighting a need for enhanced mobile-friendly web navigation; and

WHEREAS, FPWC conducts day-to-day operations and business activities through the FPWC and FPWC Golf websites including job applications, Lightspeed tee time reservations, and amenity rentals; and

WHEREAS, the Forest Preserves of Winnebago County solicited Requests for Proposals (RFP) for the development and implementation of two websites (FPWC and FPWC Golf); and

WHEREAS, five vendors out of the forty-five vendors that submitted qualifications in response to the website development and implementation RFP, were determined to be most qualified and invited to interview with the selection committee; and

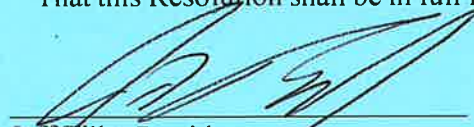
WHEREAS, after completing the interview and reference check process, the selection committee recommends awarding the work to Mark Borden (1000494823 Ontario Inc).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners of the Forest Preserves of Winnebago County approves Mark Borden (1000494823 Ontario Inc) to complete the development and implementation of two websites (FPWC and FPWC Golf) for the total cost of \$27,500, and allow the Executive Director to enter into a contract for the work to be completed.
