REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

PREPARATION OF PROPOSAL

The bidder must submit his proposal on forms furnished by the Forest Preserve. All blank spaces on the proposal form must be filled in. Authorized signature must be the individual owner of a proprietorship, a general partner of a partnership, or signed in the name of a corporation by an officer whose title shall be stated. Bids or proposals shall be sealed in an envelope and marked as required in the instructions. The bid or proposal is contained in these documents and must remain attached hereto when submitted.

TAXES NOT APPLICABLE

The Winnebago County Forest Preserve District as a Governmental Unit pays neither Federal Excise nor Illinois Retailers Occupational Tax, and therefore those taxes should be excluded from quotation. Illinois Exemption E9992-3483-06.

PROMPT PAYMENT ACT

The bid should provide that all payments are subject to the Local Governmental Prompt Payment Act.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION

Any responses and supporting documents submitted in response to a bid or proposal will be subject to disclosure under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act.

WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS OR PROPOSALS

Any bidder may withdraw their bid or proposal at any time prior to the time specified in the advertisement as the closing time for the receipt of bids or proposals by signing a request therefore. However, no bidder shall withdraw or cancel his bid or proposal for a period of sixty (60) days after said advertised closing time for the receipt of bids or proposals; the successful bidder shall not withdraw or cancel their bid or proposal after having been notified by the Forest Preserve that said bid or proposal has been accepted by the Forest Preserve Board of Commissioners.

CANCELLATION

The Winnebago County Forest Preserve District reserves the right to cancel any contract in whole or in part without penalty due to failure of the contractor to comply with terms, conditions, and specifications of this contract.

COST OF BID OR PROPOSAL

Expenses incurred in the preparation of proposals in response to this bid or proposal is the Bidder's sole responsibility

USE OF TRADE NAMES

In cases where a specified item is identified by a manufacturer's name, trade name, or other references, it is understood that the bidder proposes to furnish the item identified. If the bidder proposes to furnish an "equal," the proposed "equal" item must be so indicated in the written bid or proposal. The Forest Preserve shall be the sole determiner of the equality of the substitute offered.

REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (CONTINUED)

DELIVERIES

All materials shipped to the Winnebago County Forest Preserve District must be shipped F.O.B. designated location in Winnebago County.

DEVIATIONS, EXCEPTIONS OR ALTERNATES

Deviations, exceptions or alternates from terms, conditions, or specifications shall be described fully, on bidder's letterhead, signed, and attached to the Request for Bid or Proposal. In the absence of such statement, the bid shall be accepted as in strict compliance with all terms, conditions, and specifications and the bidder shall be held liable. Bidders are cautioned to avoid making deviations and exceptions to the specifications, which may result in rejection of their bid or proposal. If deviations, exceptions or alternates are submitted, it is the Winnebago County Forest Preserve's sole and final decision whether specifications have been met and will be considered for award.

ORDERING

Purchase orders shall be placed directly to the contractor by the Forest Preserve. No other purchase orders are authorized.

COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

All services, work and materials that in any manner affect the production, sale, or payment for the product or service contained herein must comply with all federal, state, county and municipal laws, statutes, regulations, codes, ordinances and executive orders in effect now or later and whether or not they appear in this document, including those specifically referenced herein. The successful bidder must be authorized to do business in the State of Illinois, and must be able to produce a certificate of good standing with the state of Illinois upon request.

Bidder/Contractor must obtain all licenses, certificates and other authorizations required in connection with the performance of its obligations hereunder, and Bidder/Contractor must require any and all subcontractors to do so. Failure to do so is an event of disqualification and/or default and may result in the denial of this bid and/or termination of this Agreement.

In the event federal or state funds are being used to fund this contract; additional certifications, attached as addenda, will be required. Lack of knowledge on the part of the vendor will in no way be cause for release of this obligation. If the Forest Preserve becomes aware of violation of any laws on the part of the vendor, it reserves the right to reject any bid, cancel any contract and pursue any other legal remedies deemed necessary.

PREVAILING WAGE

All bidders must bid prevailing wages.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION

The Substance Abuse Prevention on Public Works Act, Public Act 95-0635, prohibits the use of drugs and alcohol, as defined in the Act, by employees of the Contractor and by employees of all approved Subcontractors while performing work on a public works project. The Contractor/Subcontractor herewith certifies that it has a superseding collective bargaining agreement or makes the public filing of its written substance abuse prevention program for the prevention of substance abuse among its employees who are not covered by a collective bargaining agreement dealing with the subject as mandated by the Act.

II

REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (CONTINUED)

Bidders and their Subcontractors (if applicable) certifies that the entity has signed collective bargaining agreements that are in effect for all of its employees, and that deal with the subject matter of Public Act 95-0635, or certifies that the contracting entity has in place for all of its employees not covered by a collective bargaining agreement that deals with subject of the Act, and will attach the substance abuse prevention program that meets or exceeds the requirements of Public Act 95-0635.

BID PROTEST

Firms wishing to protest bids or awards shall notify the Forest Preserve in writing within 10 days after the invitation to bid opening. The notification should include the bid number, the name of the firm protesting and the reason why the firm is protesting the bid. The Forest Preserve will respond to the protest within 20 calendar days.

DISPUTES

In case of disputes as to whether or not an item or service quoted or delivered meets specifications, the decision of the Forest Preserve, or authorized representative shall be final and binding to all parties.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

These Standard Terms and Conditions of Bid or Proposal shall apply to any contract or order awarded as a result of this Request for Bid except where special requirements are stated elsewhere in the Request; in such cases the special requirements shall apply. Further, the written contract and/or order with referenced parts and attachments shall constitute the entire agreement and no other terms and conditions in any document, acceptance, or acknowledgment shall be effective or binding unless expressly agreed to in writing by the contracting authority.

PAY REQUEST

Forest Preserve makes payments once a month after the Board of Commissioners approval of invoices. The Board meets the third Wednesday of each month. The last day a pay request can be submitted for payment for the month is eight days before the Board meeting or the Tuesday a week before the Board Meeting.

When applicable Contractors are to submit a Waiver of Lien and Certified Payroll forms with requests for payment.

NON-DISCRIMINATION

In connection with the performance of work under this contract, the contractor agrees not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, religion, color, handicap, sex, physical condition, developmental disability, sexual orientation, or national origin. This provision shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer, recruitment or recruitment of compensation, and selection for training, including apprenticeship. Except with respect to sexual orientation, the contractor further agrees to take affirmative action to ensure Equal Employment Opportunities. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available for employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the contracting officer setting forth the provisions of the Non-Discrimination Clause.

REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (CONTINUED)

NON-COLLUSION

The Bidder, by its officers, agents or representatives (hereafter referred to the Bidder) present at the time of filing this bid, say that neither they nor any of them, have in any way directly or indirectly, entered into any arrangement or agreement with any other Bidders, or with any public officer or the Winnebago County Forest Preserve District, Illinois, whereby, the Bidder has not paid or is to pay to such Bidder or public officer any sum of money, anything of value or has not directly or indirectly entered into any arrangement or agreement with any other Bidder of Bidders. Whereby, no inducement of any form or character other than that which appears upon the face of the bid will be suggested, offered, paid or delivered to any person whomsoever to influence the acceptance of the said bid or understanding of any kind whatsoever, with any person whomsoever to pay, deliver to, or share with any other person in any way or manner, any of the proceeds on the Contract sought by this bid.

NON-BARRED BIDDING

The bidder is not barred from bidding on this Contract as a result of a conviction for the violation of state laws prohibiting bid rigging or bid rotating.

CERTIFICATION REGARDING DEBARMENT, SUSPENSION, INELIGIBILITY AND VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION

The bidder certifies, by submission of this proposal or acceptance of this contract, that neither it nor its principals is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in this transaction by any Federal department or agency. It further agrees by submitting this proposal that it will include this clause without modification in all lower tier transactions, solicitations, proposals, contracts, and subcontracts. Where the bidder/contractor or any lower tier participant is unable to certify to this statement, it shall attach an explanation to this solicitation/proposal. Additionally, for all new contractors and vendors to be paid the Forest Preserve Office will review the Excluded Parties List System prior to requesting the vendor be created in our accounting system.

The Bidder, by signing the bid form, acknowledges, understands and abides by all of the above "Requirements for Bidding and Instructions to Bidders".

BID INFORMATION

INTENT

It is the intent of these specifications to describe the general requirements for asphalt paving at Macktown and Four Lakes per bid specifications.

All parts not specifically mentioned in the scope of these specifications which are necessary to provide complete installation shall be furnished by the successful bidder. These specifications shall be construed as minimum.

INSURANCE

Contractor shall provide insurance to protect him and the District from claims, which may arise out of, or resulting from operations on this construction. Proof of insurance shall be submitted to the Forest Preserve District prior to construction. This insurance shall include the following types and limits:

- A. Workmen's Compensation Illinois Statutory Limits
Employers Liability \$2,000,000

- B. Comprehensive General Liability form
Limits - Bodily Damage \$2,000,000 per occurrence
 \$2,000,000 aggregate
Property Damage \$2,000,000 per occurrence
 \$2,000,000 aggregate

- C. Auto Insurance; Comprehensive form including, owned; non-owned and hired autos, uninsured motorists.
Limit - Same as General Liability

PAYMENT

Partial payment for work completed may be based on invoices, waiver of liens, and submittal of certified payroll forms received and authorized by an agent of the District. Partial payment shall be made for 90% of invoiced amount until final acceptance of work. Payment applications shall be submitted on a day of each month as required by the District (see pay request for payment schedule). Contractor may submit payment for shelter prior to construction.

The Contractor shall pay to each of his sub-contractors (and materials suppliers) the amount indicated on the waiver of lien which shall represent the amount performed by his sub-contractors for which the Contractor is requesting payment and certified payroll submitted.

WAGES OF LABORERS, MECHANICS AND OTHER WORKMEN

In accordance with the provisions of An Act of General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, County, City, or any public body or any public sub-division or by anyone under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the Winnebago County Board had previously determined where possible the generally prevailing rates of hourly wages in the locality of Winnebago County, Illinois, and; the generally prevailing rates of legal holiday and overtime work in said County, for each craft, type of workman or mechanic required to perform this contract. The terms and provisions of said Act and the generally prevailing rates of wages determined hereunder are incorporated herein by reference and are made a part of this contract. It shall be mandatory upon the Contractor and any Sub-contractor under him to pay

not less than the specified prevailing rates of wages to all laborers, workmen and mechanics employed by them in the execution of the contract.

Certified Payroll will be required with pay requests.

COMPLETION DATE

The bidder certifies by submitting this bid that he has forces available and that he will vigorously strive to complete this project by **August 1, 2024 for Macktown Projects and October 1, 2024 for Four Lakes Project.** Any other completion date should be noted on the bid form.

DETAILED BID SPECIFICATIONS

GENERAL TERMS - PLANS AND DRAWINGS

"Plans" means all drawings, sketches, and detailed plans or reproductions thereof pertaining to the construction and work involved. The attached plans and drawings are supplied to define the extent of work. All specifications are to be construed as minimum. Any discrepancies in plans, drawings and/or written specifications shall be interpreted as that of the greater required specification.

The word "agent" shall mean a representative of the Winnebago County Forest Preserve District, 5500 Northrock Drive, Rockford, Illinois 61103.

"Specifications" means all directions and requirements contained in these specifications, whether written or included by reference, together with all special provisions and written agreements made or to be made pertaining to the work involved.

CODES, PERMITS AND LICENSES

- A. All work shall conform to the Drawings and Specifications and shall comply with all applicable codes and regulations.
- B. Comply with all local and state rules, regulations, laws and ordinances, and of all other authorities having jurisdiction. All labor, materials, equipment and services necessary to make the work comply with such requirements shall be provided without additional cost to the owner.

MATERIALS STANDARDS

When not otherwise shown on the plans or herein specified, all materials incorporated in the work shall conform with current Standard Specifications of latest designation of A.S.T.M. for such materials.

MEASUREMENT OF WORK

Quantities of work completed by the Contractor will be measured and tabulated by the Agent in accordance with the methods of measurement where no particular method is so specified. The work will be paid for in accordance with such measurement and tabulations. Should the Contractor question the Agent, the Agent and the Contractor, or their representatives, shall together remeasure any portions of the work in question and determine the correct quantities to be used in making payment under the contract.

TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION FACILITIES

The Contractor shall erect and maintain suitable barricades and other safety measures for protection of the public and the work.

VEGETATION

No trees or shrubs shall be cut, pruned, or removed without authorization of the Winnebago County Forest Preserve district.

SITE PREPARATION

Contractor to coordinate this operation with the project manager, Vaughn Stamm - Director of Operations, (815) 877-6100 or (815) 494-4119 – mobile phone. Equipment may be stored on-site. Note site is not fenced and unsecure in the evening. No staff is on-site during off hours.

DESCRIPTION/DETAILS OF WORK

ITEM # 1:

MACKTOWN FOREST PRESERVE 2221 FREEPORT ROAD, ROCKTON, IL 61072

PRESERVE ROADWAY, PARKING LOT, AND CART PATH ASPHALT PAVING

SCOPE OF WORK

To provide asphalt repaving in the Macktown Forest Preserve on portions of roadways and parking lots near shelter and visitor's center, and select areas around golf clubhouse. Additionally, a new section of cart path to be added next to clubhouse and also to provide sealcoat and striping to cart parking lot next to clubhouse. Location of desired work is Macktown Forest Preserve & golf course, 2221 Freeport Road, Rockton, Illinois 61072, as outlined below and shown on map.

1. All project work for golf clubhouse will need to occur only on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesdays, and be pre-scheduled at least (7) seven days in advance in order for golf operations to make customer accommodations.
2. Preserve roadway work may necessitate that preserve roadway access be closed to the public at the golf intersection in order for project work to take place. Prior arrangements need to be made at least (7) seven days in advance. (project work on these portions of asphalt roadway & parking lots can occur Monday-Friday).
 - a. Must have access & parking available for event on Tuesday, June 18, 2024.
3. Project work completion preferred/desired to be by August 1, 2024.

PROJECT SPECS

1. CART PATH ASPHALT RE-PAVING AND NEW ADDITIONS (approx. 3,305 total sq ft of asphalt)

SCOPE OF WORK

- Remove area of two existing landscaped islands in cart parking lot, core out to provide new 9' wide path addition, & path widening; add 6" stone to subbase and pave with of 2" overlay (per aerial), proving smooth transitions to existing cart lot pavement. (approximately 1,515 sq ft)
- Haul debris off site.
- Rework existing path stone sub-base and add stone as needed for maximum grade and drainage.
- Cut butt joints in asphalt to provide for smooth transitions.
- Hard compact all exposed stone.
- Hot asphalt pave 2" finish thickness asphalt mat. (approx. 1,790 sq ft)
- Compact hard surface and finish edges.

DETAILED BID SPECIFICATIONS (CONTINUED)

2. SEAL COAT & RE-STRIPE CART PARKING LOT (approx. 10,425 sq ft)

SCOPE OF WORK

- Clean cart parking area of dirt and debris.
- Seal coat asphalt (spray applied) cart parking lot using premium commercial grade petroleum emulsion sealer at a rate of 0.11 to 0.13 gallons per square yard, with (TARMAX R-100) latex additive or equivalent hardener for additional strength and (Black Beauty) or equivalent sand (100 lbs. per 200 gals.).
- Re-stripe cart parking stalls with solid center line with 4" White paint, which meets Federal and State specs; applied at a rate of 16 mills wet thickness in existing pattern.
- Stencil numbers for each cart parking stall 1 – 52, with white paint.

3. REPAVE PRESERVE ASPHALT ROADWAY

SCOPE OF WORK

ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION AREA "A"

- Mill in place 1,267 sq. yds. of existing asphalt drive lane as shown on drawing.
- Utilize millings to add to the existing base stone creating a hybrid base to help stabilize the subgrade.
- Final grade pulverized base work to achieve maximum grade and drainage for new asphalt.
- Add extra stone as required to obtain drainage or elevation adjustments.
- Hard compact loose material with vibratory roller.
- Install 255 lineal feet of B6-18 curb and gutter.
- Surface mill as necessary 1,450 sq. yds. of road patches with butt joints.
- Furnish and pave new 3" Hot Mix Asphalt pavement.
- Hard compact HMA pavement and finish edges flush with existing asphalt.

ROADWAY DRIVE LANE AREA "B"

- Prep 1,484 sq. yds. for 2" overlay.
- Cut butt joints in asphalt where needed.
- Machine sweep surface area to be overlaid remove debris from site.
- Tack coat existing asphalt pavement.
- Install new 2" Hot Mix Asphalt pavement.
- Hard compact HMA pavement and finish edges flush with existing asphalt.

ROADWAY AREA "C"

- Prep 1,708 sq. yds. for 2" overlay.
- Cut butt joints in asphalt where needed.
- Machine sweep surface area to be overlaid remove debris from site.
- Tack coat existing asphalt pavement.
- Install new 2" Hot Mix Asphalt pavement.
- Hard compact HMA pavement and finish edges flush with existing asphalt.

DETAILED BID SPECIFICATIONS (CONTINUED)

OPTION #1 - ROADWAY OVERLAY AREA "D"

- Prep 3,340 sq. yds. for 2" overlay.
- Cut butt joints in asphalt where needed.
- Machine sweep surface area to be overlaid remove debris from site.
- Tack coat existing asphalt pavement.
- Install new 2" Hot Mix Asphalt pavement.
- Hard compact HMA pavement and finish edges flush with existing asphalt.

JOB SPECIFIC NOTES

*If extra stone is required to obtain proper drainage or elevation adjustments it will be billed as additional cost to the contract at \$_____ per ton.

*If bad sub-soil issues are found they will be brought to the attention of the Forest Preserves and a cost to repair these areas will be provided before the work is completed.

Note: No final dirt grading or seeding to be included in project bids.

ADDITIONAL JOB NOTES

During some project construction, the golf course may remain open to the public. Golf carts will be re-located and customers will be re-routed around the clubhouse areas. Golf Course may facilitate the need to close for 1-2 days, which would need to occur on a Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday only, and with at least 7 days advance notice.

Parking bumpers in preserve parking lot area will be removed by FPWC staff prior to project.

ENTRANCE LANES & PARKING LOT

SCOPE OF WORK

To mill & pave the existing roadway at four lakes forest preserve as outlined below, with option to install new concrete curb & gutter.

* Project work desired to commence after June 16, 2024 and completion by October 1, 2024.

PROJECT SPECS

1. ROTO-MILL 2" REMOVAL & REPLACE ASPHALT PAVEMENT (approx. 16,000 sq. ft.)

SCOPE OF WORK

- 2" asphalt removal and placement of new asphalt pavement as shown on drawing.
- Mill and remove existing asphalt as needed for new 2" asphalt pavement.
- Excess millings generated during this process to be disposed of, offsite, at an approved recycle center.

IV

DETAILED BID SPECIFICATIONS (CONTINUED)

- To remove the existing concrete curb and core out the existing soil from (2) islands and install new 8" stone base and prep for paving.
- Final grade existing stone base, to achieve maximum grade and drainage, and prep for new asphalt pavement.
- Furnish and pave new 2" HMA pavement.
- Compact surface with vibratory roller, & finish edges.
- To stripe existing layout stalls 4" Yellow paint in existing pattern, including handicap stall(s).

OPTION #1 - CONCRETE CURB & GUTTER AT EAST ENTRANCE

- To remove and replace the existing concrete curb & gutter at the east entrance as shown on drawing.
- The new concrete to be a curb & gutter type to replace the existing barrier curb.

JOB SPECIFIC NOTES

*If extra stone is required to obtain proper drainage or elevation adjustments it will be billed as additional cost to the contract at \$_____ per ton.

*If bad sub-soil issues are found they will be brought to the attention of the Forest Preserves and a cost to repair these areas will be provided before the work is completed.

ADDITIONAL JOB NOTES

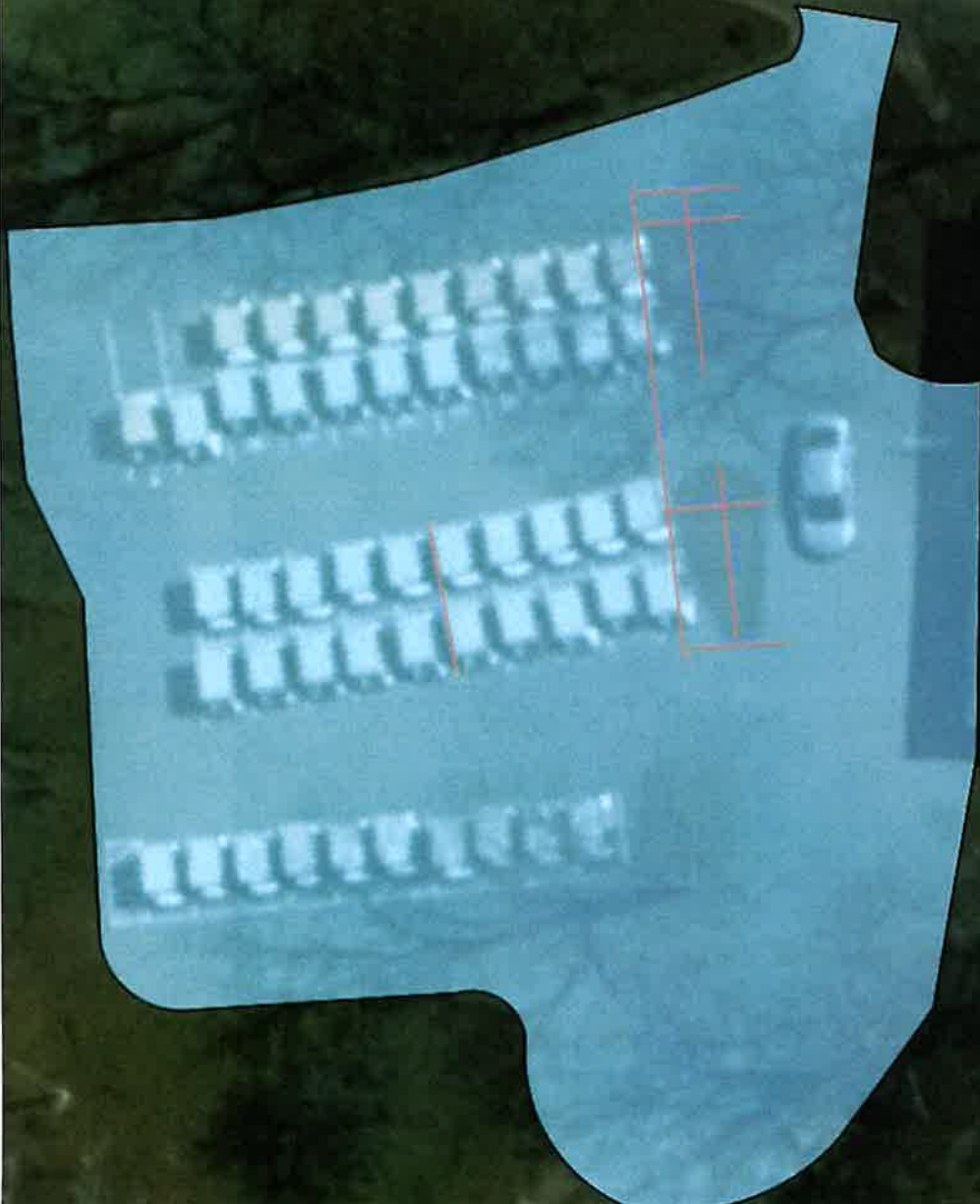
During project construction, the preserve entrance can be closed to the public. Project should be conducted during normal week day hours.

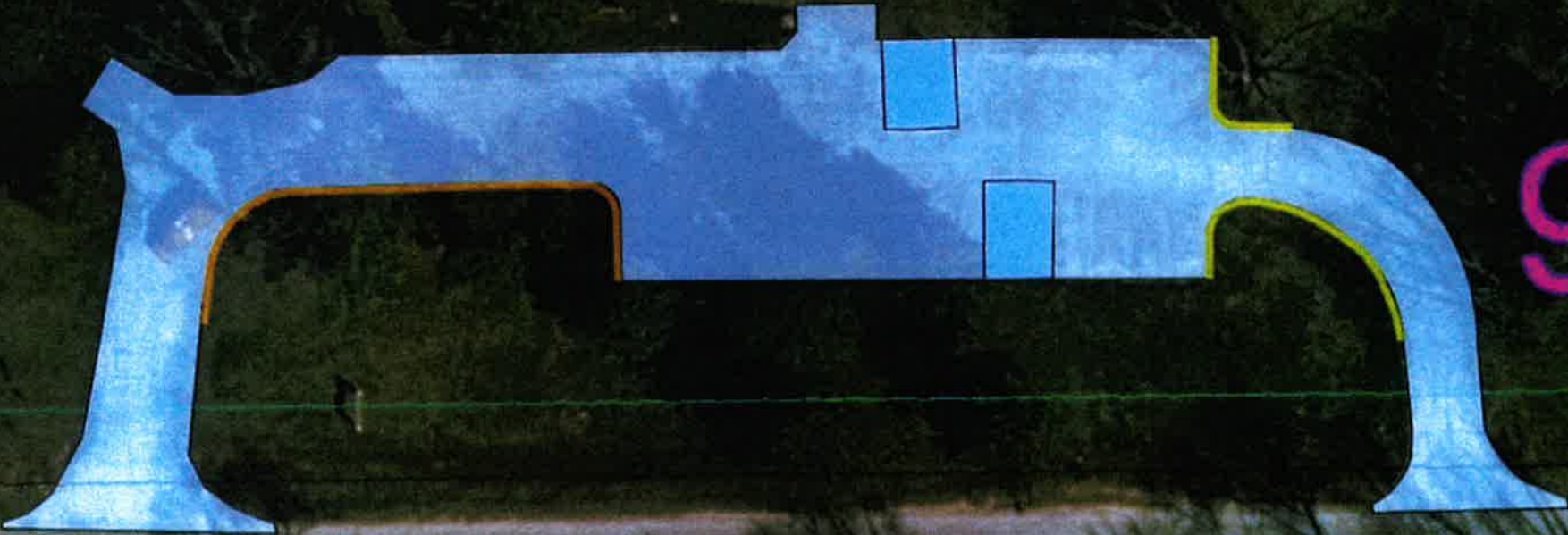
